COORDINATED HURRICANE HELENE REBUILD PROGRAM Three Forks Baptist Association, NC Baptist on Mission Disaster Relief, and NC Baptist State Convention



Our Three Forks Baptist Association is excited to announce that we are partnering with Baptist on Mission and NC Baptist to continue recovery efforts and bring this rebuild program to the High Country! We're excited that Gerald Hodges has accepted the Disaster Rebuild & Recovery Coordinator position for our area. This is a joint effort of the Three Forks Baptist Association and NC Baptist on Mission.



FROM THREE FORKS ASSOCIATION

While recovery efforts continue in many areas, helping homeowners remove trees and dispose of water-logged material, the Essential Rapid Repairs (ERR) program has begun with a goal of rebuilding up to 500-1000 homes. We desire to help families return to a safe, secure, functional home as soon as possible. It won't be a complete rebuild; workers will return later to finish the process, but at least they can move back home.

We'll need licensed plumbers, electricians, and people with construction skills in the coming months. We'll also need individuals prepared to lend a hand wherever needed.
